Go to the far back (Northwest) of the sno-park, past all the snowmobiles to find the dogs and skiers area (groomed trails parking signs). We are also planning to have a late lunch at Jay Berry's [good sandwiches, beer, soup, pie, coffee] at the North Bend Mall afterward if you are interested.
